

## Revised criteria and Schedule for BE/BTech First Year admissions

In order to avoid delay in admissions for the session 2021-22, TIET has decided to revise its criteria of admissions to BE/BTech 1<sup>st</sup> year as per the following.

### Eligibility:

The candidate

- i. has passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with at least 70% marks (65% for SC/ST candidates) in aggregate of three subjects, namely, **Physics, Mathematics** and any one subject out of **Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology and Technical Vocational subject\*** OR Minimum 70% (65% for SC/ST candidates) marks in a Diploma recognized by AICTE or a state board of technical education of at least 3-year duration.
- ii. has appeared in JEE (Main)-2021

- iii. possesses a good moral character.
- iv. is a citizen of India.
- v. has passed 10+2 examination in 2019, 2020 or appearing in 2021.

### Admission Criteria:

The admission shall be made on the basis of merit of aggregate of three subjects namely, **Physics, Mathematics** and any one subject out of **Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology and Technical Vocational subject\***. In the event of a tie, the same will be broken as per the following criteria.

\*List of Technical Vocational Subjects:

- i. Biology
- ii. Biotechnology
- iii. Computer Science
- iv. Informatics Practices
- v. Multimedia and Web Technologies
- vi. Engineering Graphics
- vii. Information storage and Retrieval
- viii. Electronics
- ix. Electrical Maintenance
- x. General Civil Engineering
- xi. Mechanical Maintenance
- xii. Agriculture
- xiii. Business Studies

### **Tie-Breaker:**

The tie at 10+2 PCM marks shall be broken by overall percentile score of JEE Main – February/March 2021. Best of the two (JEE Main – February 2021/March 2021) overall percentile will be taken into account. In case of tie at overall percentile, the same shall be broken by following order:

- a) Candidates obtaining higher Percentile Score in Mathematics in the JEE Main considered for tie break.
- b) Candidates obtaining higher Percentile Score in Physics in the JEE(Main) considered for tie break.
- c) Candidates obtaining higher Percentile Score in Chemistry in the JEE(Main) considered for tie break.
- d) Candidates with higher marks in English at 10+2.
- e) Candidates older in age to be preferred.

### **Note:**

As and when JEE Main - 2021 result is declared, admissions for vacant seats (if any) in subsequent rounds of counselling will be done based on JEE Main – 2021 All India rank (AIR) only. For admission on the basis of JEE Main – 2021, a candidate must fulfil the following eligibility criteria.

### **Important Dates:**

**Last date for receipt of completed application forms: August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021  
to be eligible for three rounds of online counselling**

### **Note:**

Application form will remain open after the last date (August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021). However, candidates who will be applying after 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2021, will not be considered for first three rounds of online counselling (2<sup>nd</sup> August, 19<sup>th</sup> August and 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2021). To be eligible for a particular round of counselling (after three rounds of online counselling), a candidate must have applied three days prior to that particular counselling round.

Candidate once offered admission in a particular round of online counselling, if failed to deposit the fee as per the prescribed timeline, he/she will not be considered for upgradation/admission in subsequent round(s) of online counselling. Only the candidates who will deposit the fee as per the prescribed timeline or the candidates who have not been offered admission till the latest round of counselling, will be considered for admission/upgradation in subsequent rounds of online counselling.

**In case of vacant seats (if any) after the third round of online counselling, Institute may conduct more round(s) of online counselling(s). Information regarding the further round(s) of counselling(s), if any, shall be intimated on the website.**
